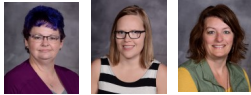

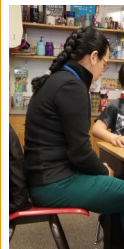
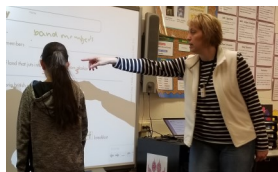
Counseling Services

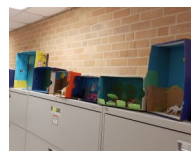
SDSU brings music to CHS for an afternoon concert!

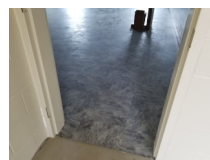
